BIBLE PREACHERS: Stephen NO. 2
James Pilgrim

This is the second look at Bible Preachers: Stephen. The first study covered verses 1-12. This lesson begins with verse 13. Joseph could have had his father and brethren put to death. He did not. He wept aloud, revealed himself to them, and brought them down to Egypt, where they were given the land of Goshen, the best part of the land of Egypt. (Genesis 45:1ff; 46:1, 66, 11). By the way, do not miss the number of times Joseph's brethren bow to him, especially in Genesis 44, and note Genesis 37. Jacob and others died in Egypt, and were buried in the sepulchre Abraham purchased from the sons of Emmor the father of Sychem. (Genesis 23). This happened when Sarah died. (Genesis 23).

While still in Egypt, the land part of God's promise to Abraham drew nigh. (Genesis 15:13; 12:1-3). While still in Egypt, Israel's population grew and multiplied. (Acts 7:17). At this point, Stephen said, "Another king arose, which knew not Joseph. The same dealt subtilly with our Kindred, and evil entreated our fathers...." (Verses 18, 19; Exodus 1:6-22). Moses was born at this time, and was hidden by his parents, Amram and Jochebed (Exodus 6:20), in his father's house for three months. (Acts 7:20; Exodus 2:1, 2). Jochebed put Moses in the river, just not like Pharaoh had wanted. (Acts 7:19-21; Exodus 2:3, 4). Stephen describes how Pharaoh's daughter took Moses and raised him as her own son in the house of her father, the Pharaoh who had called for his and others deaths. (Acts 7:21; Exodus 2:5, 6). Moses' sister, Miriam (Numbers 26:59), watched over Moses, and convinced Pharaoh's daughter to use Moses' mother to nurse him. (Exodus 2:7-10) Moses, therefore, had the best of two worlds. He was raised by his mother, an Hebrew woman, while being "learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and was mighty in words and in deeds." (Acts 7:22; Compare Luke 24:19).

Stephen reminds them of the one hundred twenty years of Moses' life, divided into three multiples of forty years each. (Acts 7:23-42). The first forty years of Moses life were spent in Egypt. (Acts 7:23-29; Exodus 2:1-15). Stephen follows Moses to Madian (Midian), following his slaying the Egyptian, and attempting to bring peace between two fighting Israelites. (Acts 7:23 married Zipporah, who bare him two sons, Gershom and Eliezer. (Exodus 18:2-4). She was the daughter of Reuel, also called Jethro and Jethroam and Raguel (Exodus 18:2, 6; Numbers 10:29), priest of Midian (Acts 2:29; Exodus 2:15-22). Midian is where Moses lives until God calls him to lead Israel out of oppression. (Acts 7:30-35; Exodus 3:1-4:28). The third forty years of Moses' life were spent in delivering the people from Egyptian bondage up to, but not into the promised land. (Acts 7:35, 36; Deuteronomy 34:1-6).

Stephen described Moses, who had said, 'a prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear. This is he, that was in the church in the wilderness with the angel which spake unto him in the mount Sinai, and with our fathers: who received the lively oracles to give unto us: To whom our fathers would not obey, but thrust him from them, and in their hearts turned back again into Egypt, Saying unto Aaron, Make us gods to go before us: for as for this Moses, which brought us out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him. And they made a calf in those days, and offered sacrifice unto the idol, and rejoiced in the works of their own hands." "Wot" in English is "Know." (Acts 7:37-41; Deuteronomy 18:15-22; Exodus 32). How did God receive their words and actions? The Lord willing, to be continued.
